The Synod of Alberta and the Territories and IELCO (Iglesia Evangelica Luterana de Colombia) have been in a companion relationship since 2003. The intent of this relationship is to develop and nurture a friendship between Canadian and Colombian Lutherans and, when mutually agreed upon by both synods, assist with funding for approved projects.

In 1956, a Lutheran school in Sogamoso, Boyaca was cofounded by Joyce Bergh, who was born in Cereal, Alberta and served as a missionary and teacher in Colombia for over 20 years. One of the greatest achievements of Joyce's ministry occurred when the government eventually granted accreditation to the Sogamoso school. The Colombian government now requires the school to upgrade its facilities in order to maintain its accreditation and government subsidies.
